Audience

These workshops are designed for those working with children with Down syndrome in their school or their class, including teachers, teaching and support assistants, Special Educational Needs Coordinators and advisory teachers. It is also suitable for parents.

Aims

These workshops, facilitated by Leela Baksi speech and language therapist (senior clinical specialist- complex needs with Symbol UK Ltd) provide an opportunity to look at behaviour management in relation to children who have Down Syndrome in Primary phase. The workshops will explore factors that contribute to tricky behaviour, and use functional behaviour analysis (ABC) to understand behaviours and consider ways of responding.

Please come prepared to hear about and/or contribute to in-depth discussion around participants experiences of managing (or not!) behaviours.

The day will include two workshop sessions, one for school staff focusing on behaviour in school settings, and one for families and anyone else covering behaviour in any setting.

In general Leela suggests that families do not attend the session focusing on behaviour in school as this facilitates honest and uninhibited discussions with school staff, who otherwise have a duty to convey confidence in structures and strategies when with families.

Participant numbers are limited to 12 per workshop.
